- Maintains cleanliness of work and dining areas surfaces, chairs, tables, garbage, floors, dishes, cutlery and condiment containers, dirty dish carts and salad bar.
- Ensure any client spills cleaned and wet floor signage put up.
- Portions desserts for in house and shelter clients and maintains cleanliness of desert cooler.
- Maintains and ensures the beverage station is refilled as required and cleaned regularly.
- Interact with the cook/s on duty as to availability of fresh fruit or desserts to the loading dock by the van driver
 or other sources of donations.
- Informs Supervisor, Manager or Cook when stock of food service items is running low.
- Set-up the small and large dining rooms for breakfast, lunch and dinner services.
- Sets up snacks for staff breaks,
- Adapts work practices within specific parameters to ensure the efficient delivery of food services

- Follows guidelines for the safety and security of food and equipment and monitors practices to ensure adherence
- Maintains a safe environment
- Performs other duties as assigned
